Boone Hospital Center Pain Management Clinic Relocation



The project consisted of the interior renovation of approximately 5,650 square feet to convert the former sleep lab into a new Pain Management Clinic. The primary goal of this renovation was to create a larger clinic that would allow for a multidisciplinary approach to help treat pain, including: physical therapy, cognitive behavioral therapy, biofeedback techniques, and surgical options.

The space was renovated to double the number of exam rooms and recovery bays for patients. Additionally, the project created individual offices for staff members as well as three nurses' stations to support the patient spaces. Lastly, the project created an additional treatment room which allows the staff to conduct concurrent procedures, thus expanding the services offered to their patients.

Another challenge to the project was interfacing with an adjacent project for a double egress door as well as an air handler upgrade in the adjacent mechanical room. Though the Pain Management Clinic only moved across the corridor from their previous location, the new larger area enables more space for staff to offer expanded services to patients in a comfortable environment. The selected interior finishes warm cherry and calming neutral colors are in keeping with hospital standards. The completion of the project creates a new Pain Management Clinic that is both beautiful and functional for patients and staff. It enables the clinic to offer a full scope of practice, helping patients by utilizing medication management, interventional treatment as well as advanced technologies.
