Boone Hospital Center Pediatric Wing



Bubbles and hues of soft blues and purples, 'porthole' light fixtures and wavy glass create an immersion into an aquatic themed Pediatric Unit. Renovation of this 3,621 sf unit included an eight bed Pediatric Nursery with satellite nurse station to accommodate the needs of infants transitioning down from intensive care and also children lacking parental involvement. Full height window walls and sliding doors allow for communication and visual connection between the main and satellite nurse stations and allow soft natural light to stream through the bubble adorned glass walls into the main corridor. Additionally, two private rooms, two semiprivate/isolation rooms, play area, treatment area and ancillary service areas all carry varying levels of the aquatic theme.

Located at the end of, and accessed through, the patient-occupied 2nd floor wing, SOA incorporated special considerations for construction phasing and the contractor's use of the premises in the project documents.
