Boone Electric Cooperative



On September 18, 2019, the Boone Electric Cooperative Board of Directors voted unanimously to approve a project that will greatly improve the headquarters at the cooperative's current location on Rangeline Street. The board hired local general contractor Coil Construction to oversee the project that will include both new buildings and rehabilitation of existing ones. In February of 2020, the board accepted staff's recommendation of SOA as the main architect to work with Coil Construction.

SOA led programming efforts to confirm and optimize the office related functions of the Coil Construction master plan, helping evaluate options to reuse, renovate, or rebuild various portions of the campus with the next 50 years of the organization's future in mind. SOA worked alongside Coil's team, which included a separate architecture firm specializing in the service yard and vehicle service building portion of the project. Together, SOA facilitated the overall design through rapid photorealistic renderings, real-time walkthroughs, and design revisions through Building Information Modelling practices.

The resulting design provides a welcoming Community Building and main lobby for members, while addressing security and safety concerns, optimizing the organization and interaction of the various functions of BEC, creating an engaging work environment, and planning for future growth.

The multi-phase project is expected to be completed the Fall of 2022.
